



How to Survive Registration & Check In:

“FULDA GAP 101”

- 1: Get to Command Decisions Wargames Center as early as possible. All services (registration, chrono, air fills, paint trailer) will open on Friday at noon. The field will open at 7am on Saturday morning but if you wait until then, there will be lines to deal with and fewer camping spaces! Camping spaces are limited, camp conservatively!
- 2: Each player will need a new waiver for this event. This is a safety requirement. The field needs the most recent information on you available. Under 18 years old? Download your waiver from cdpaintball.com, have a parent sign it, and bring it with you.
- 3: Check- in stations are clearly marked this year. If you are pre-registered - go to your unit side, either the “Warsaw Pact Registration” or “NATO” Registration banners in the store parking area. If you are registering at the field, go under the banner marked “walk on registrations” and into the store to get checked in.
4. We will be issuing paint tickets in either the store location or at the pre-registration check in areas. Do NOT lose your tickets, they are worth cash and are non refundable. Valken will be keeping your paintballs in a climate control environment where you may claim your paint with ticket at your convenience. THIS IS A FIELD PAINT ONLY EVENT. NO EXCEPTIONS.

Paint price: Zing = \$40 per case and Redemption = \$50.00 per case. *We do not sell by the bag.* **WE RECYCLE PAINTBALL BOXES. LOOK FOR DISPOSAL SITES.**

5. After checking in at registration, go immediately to the Safety Briefing Hippie Bus. You will watch a short video, and receive approval by your safety Ref.
6. Get to the chronograph range quickly! Bring tools to adjust your velocity with you so you aren't waiting on others who are using ours.
7. Bring either cash, or cash *and* credit cards with you. The store takes credit but some vendors may not, (food vendors & surplus in particular). The store cannot give cash advances.
8. Study the game schedule – it's posted at www.fuldagap.com and READ AND KNOW THE RULES (including camping rules). Ignorance isn't bliss - Rule breaking will not be tolerated.
10. Air Fill stations will be located at near the entry points for either side. You must have your player identification and be safety briefed before air fills will be performed.
